7 Ways to Make Your Home More Energy Efficient

1. Make sure your walls and attic are well insulated. Find an energy expert near you. <http://greenhomeguide.com> has the nation's #1 directory of local green home professionals.
2. Upgrade or replace windows. According to EnergyStar.gov, replacing windows will save 7-24% of your heating and air-conditioning bills.
3. Plant shade trees and shrubs around your house. If your house is older, with relatively poor insulation and windows, good landscaping (particularly deciduous trees) can save energy.
4. Replace an older air conditioner with a high-efficiency system.
5. Improve the efficiency of your hot water system. First, turn down the temperature of your water heater to the warm setting (120°F). Second, insulate your hot water lines so they don't cool off as quickly between uses. Third, use low-flow fixtures for showers & baths.
6. Replace incandescent light bulbs with compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs). CFLs can save 3/4 of the electricity used by incandescents. Most people don't think about the fact that electricity to run a light bulb costs much more than the bulb itself. One of the new CFLs cost about \$2-\$3, but it lasts 10,000 hours and uses only about 27 watts to generate as much light as a 100-watt incandescent bulb.
7. If you buy a new refrigerator, don't leave the old one plugged in. Avoid the temptation to use the old fridge as a backup for party supplies and liquid refreshment. The extra storage space will cost you: figure an extra \$50-\$150 per year in electricity to keep that older fridge running.
